NOW SCANNING  
ARIZONA FOR INTERNS!



The Arizona Interns-In-Action program is employing an advanced technology graphic tool to reach potential interns. It's called a QR (Quick Response) code and appears as a graphic symbol (as shown) on AIIA communication materials. When this code is scanned by anyone with a Smartphone, it opens directly to the Arizona Interns-In-Action web site where the viewer can access the entire intern program, plus the directory of over 50 participating state of Arizona government agencies. As Thomas Szewczyk, graphic designer and webmaster on the AIIA team put it, "By adding the QR code to our communication materials, students will have instant access to our program and the intern opportunities here at the state."
